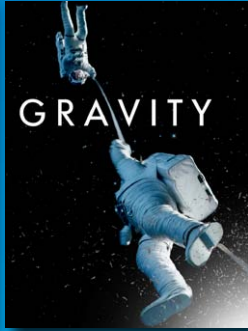

The title for November is 'Alias Grace' by Margaret Atwood, a novel based on a real double murder that occurred in Toronto in the 1850s. Grace Marks was a 15 year-old servant in household of Mr. Kinnear. He and his mistress Nancy, also a servant, were found dead in the cellar. Grace and the stable-hand James McDermott had gone missing and shortly afterward were found just over the border in the U.S. with Kinnear's and Nancy's belongings. They were apprehended and returned to Toronto

for trial, which resulted in both being found guilty. McDermott was hanged, and Grace was sentenced to death but had her sentence reduced to life in prison. Atwood imagines Grace's history and what might have really happened. Based around the true story of one of the most enigmatic and notorious women of the 1840s, Margaret Atwood has created an extraordinarily potent tale of sexuality, cruelty and mystery.
