What to do if you find a dicarded needle?


1. Do not be alarmed.

2. Get a rigid walled, puncture resistant, plastic container, with a well-secured, screw top lid (not glass, aluminium, or frosted plastic).




3. Bring the container to the needle and place it on the ground.

4. Pick up the needle from the blunt end – do not touch the sharp point.



Put the needle, point first, into the container.



8. Put the container in a domestic rubbish bin.

What to do if you get a needle stick injury?

WASHIT

Wash the area gently with soap and running tap water as soon as possible.



COVER IT

Apply an antiseptic and a clean dressing.



REPORT IT

Obtain prompt medical advice from your local doctor or hospital emergency department, preferably within 24 hours.



DISPOSE IT

Dispose of the needle safely.
