Name Port Hedland's new business precinct



The Town of Port Hedland is preparing to market and sell a number of lots for commercial/retail/showroom purposes, in the area known as 'Precinct 3', adjacent to the Port Hedland International Airport. As part of this process, the community are invited to submit

a name for the new business precinct, which will provide residents with additional commercial, retail and lifestyle options.

All names submitted will be assessed by a judging panel selected by the Town of Port Hedland, with the final selection presented to Council at the Ordinary Council Meeting on Wednesday 27 March for adoption.

Submissions need to meet the following requirements:

- Reflects the strategic location of the precinct between the Port and South Hedland Town Centres, and the Port Hedland International Airport, which will also be the base for an international freight hub
- Considers the future use and development (such as commercial, showroom, industrial and retail uses)
- Considers resource industry accommodation, usage and community integration
