The Slam returns for 2014

Successful youth engagement program The Slam is back for 2014 and is promising to be bigger and better than last year!

This year's program is delivered by the JD Hardie Youth Zone in partnership with Department of Corrective Services – Youth Services, WA Police Community Engagement Division, the Youth Involvement Council, Wirraka Maya Health Services and the Hedland Youth Stakeholder Action Group (HYSAG).

The first Slam session will be held on Friday 2 May, 6pm to 9pm and will run every Friday fortnight until the end of October.
