No more waiting for trains at Wallwork Road

Monday 19 May will be remembered as one of the most significant days in local history - it was the day that traffic delays at Wallwork Road became a thing of the past as the new overpass bridge was officially opened by stakeholders and Mr Wallwork himself.

As a group of funding partners, project stakeholders, media and high school vocational training students gathered on Wallwork Road Bridge, Member for Pilbara Brendon Grylls, BHPBIO track and signals manager Carl Singh, Mayor Kelly Howlett and ex-Main Roads long-term employee Mike Wallwork officially declared the bridge open with a ribbon cutting.

The bridge was opened to the public not long after, to the delight of many community members who were eagerly anticipating driving on the new bridge after weeks of detours.

The Wallwork Road Bridge project was designed and constructed by Main Roads WA and John Holland, with funding from State Government's Royalties for Regions Pilbara Cities program, BHP Billiton Iron Ore and the Town of Port Hedland.
