

TOWN OF PORT HEDLAND WASTE LOCAL LAW 2018

The Town of Port Hedland's Council has adopted the 'Town of Port Hedland Waste Local Law 2018'.

The purpose of this local law is to provide a statutory framework for the management and enforcement of laws relating to waste management within the Town of Port Hedland.

The effect of this local law is to stipulate the responsibilities of the Town and its rate payers in relation to waste management across the town, as well as the best practice management of the towns waste management facilities, and to provide capacity to enforce contraventions to the laws.
