

TOWN OF PORT HEDLAND

Notice of Intention to Levy Differential Rates

The Town of Port Hedland is in the process of finalising its Budget for the 2019/20 financial year, which has been based on a zero based budgeting approach focusing on driving efficiencies throughout the organisations various service and business units. The Town continues to move towards a uniform rating model and work to provide a level of certainty and consistency for ratepayers with a stable long term rates model. The following are the proposed Differential General Rates and Minimum Payments for the Town of Port Hedland for the 2019/20 financial year, to be implemented on 1 July 2019.

GRV Commercial / Industrial	9.7222	\$1,900
GRV Mass and Tourist Accommodation	19.3958	\$1,900

UV Mining and Other	19.9430	\$200

Submissions are invited from any elector or ratepayer with respect to the proposed rates, and any related matters, within a minimum 21 days of the date of this notice.
