Town's initiative to boost recycling in Hedland

The Town, Care for Hedland, and WARRRL have recently teamed up to deliver Containers for Change baskets across public bins in Hedland.

The branded baskets are attached to public general waste bins, giving people the option to recycle cans and bottles while out and about.

The pilot program will run for two months, after which the Town's Sustainability team will assess whether to make the program permanent.

The community is encouraged to collect contents from the baskets and drop them off at the main Containers for Change depot in Wedgefield to receive the 10c deposit, all whilst supporting Care for Hedland's Refund Point Operations.



Sustainability is a collective effort, and by redirecting eligible containers from landfill to recycling facilities, we can work towards building a more sustainable Hedland.
