



2026 Local Government election

The Port Hedland Local Government election will happen on Saturday 28 March 2026. The community will decide who they want to lead the Town of Port Hedland by electing a Mayor and eight Councillors. Your vote will be vital in deciding who will represent the Port Hedland community on Council. The election will be by postal vote. When you are enrolled, you will get your voting papers direct to your mailbox.

Check your enrolment details

If you're already enrolled to vote in the state and federal elections for Port Hedland, you'll receive a voting pack in your mailbox between late February and early March.

You can check your enrolment details on the AEC or WAEC websites by providing your surname, given name, date of birth and residential address.

Your voice matters



When completing the enrolment form, you will need to share one of the following; your Australian driver's license number, your Medicare card number, your Australian passport number or have someone who is currently enrolled and can confirm your identity.

Enrol to vote

If you meet the requirements to vote in the state and federal elections and have recently moved to Port Hedland, turned 18, or become an Australian citizen then you may need to update your details, or enrol to vote.

To vote in the Local Government election, your enrolment details must be updated by the end of January 2026. Go to the AEC website and complete the enrolment form.

If you're not enrolled, you can't vote.


