DOGS LOCAL LAW

The Town of Port Hedland proposes to make the '**Town of Port Hedland Dogs Local Law 2021**'.

The purpose of this local law is to provide for the additional controls and management of matters relating to dogs that are not specified in the *Dog Act 1976* and provide clarity to promote and encourage responsible dog ownership within the Town of Port Hedland (Town).

The effect of the Dogs Local Law 2021 is to provide regulatory measures in relation to impounding of dogs, the number of dogs that can be kept, establishment of approved kennels and the manner in which dogs are to be confined by the occupier of the premises and to promote and encourage responsible dog ownership whilst providing authority to enforce the laws and administer fines.
