Local Planning Policy LPP/02 – Advertising Signs

Notice is hereby given that the Town of Port Hedland (Town) has adopted the above mentioned Local Planning Policy.

The Policy has been developed to provide guidance on development applications for signage and instances where development approval is not required from the Town.

Objectives of the Policy include:

- (i) Ensure that signage is established and maintained to a high standard;
- (ii) Ensure the display of signage does not adversely impact on the amenity of neighbouring land;
- (iii) Ensure the display of signage does not adversely impact the level of safety for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians by obstructing sight lines; and
- (iv) Protect the significance of heritage places.

The Policy can be viewed on the Town's website under Local Planning Policies and has been deposited at the Town's Administration Office located at the Civic Centre on McGregor Street, Port Hedland.
