Starts Monday 4 September



Cyclone season is just around the corner, which means it's time to clear excess green waste from your property. It is important to minimise the risk of flying debris during a cyclonic weather event.

The Town will start collecting kerbside green waste from Monday 4 September. Please make sure all green waste is no longer than 1.5 metres in length and does not cause any obstruction to roads and pathways, or prevent garbage trucks accessing bins.

How do I put green waste on the kerb?



Please make sure clippings are no longer than 1.5 metres each



Please make sure green waste clippings are neatly stacked



Leaves should be placed in a non-plastic bag or cardboard box



Please do not let piles or bags obstruct pathways or infrastructure

How do I dispose of other waste?



If you have waste other than green waste in your yard, please visit the South Hedland Landfill to dispose of these items.
