Wilson Street Shared Bike Path Project

Connecting Port and South Hedland



Key Project Benefits

- ✓ Full connection between Port and South Hedland for cyclists and pedestrians.
- ✓ Improves safety for drivers, cyclists and pedestrians along Wilson Street.
- ✓ Encourages active lifestyles by providing an additional pathway.
- ✓ Strengthens Hedland's overall pathway network to improve amenity and livability.

The Town is now constructing the Wilson Street shared bike and pedestrian path, which will link the cycle network from Redbank Bridge to Cooke Point Drive and McGregor Street in Port Hedland.

The project is made possible by a Western Australia Bicycle Network (WABN) grant from the Department of Transport.

Once completed, the linked pathway will encourage more residents to cycle and walk between Port and South Hedland as well as linking tourists to key points of interest.

Construction is expected to be completed in October or November 2022.
