Park and South Hedland Aquatic Centre Redevelopment projects, following the delayed opening of both facilities and the continuing work on water balancing and completion of works.

The next round of statutory water sampling is expected to be undertaken at both facilities on Tuesday 29 January.

Results will be received by the Town later that week with details provided to the community and our stakeholders via the daily updates.
