GPs receive keys to their new homes

The GP Housing project has reached its final milestone, with Kinetic Health and OSH Medical Group receiving the keys to the seven new dwellings which form part of the subsidised GP Housing provided by the Town of Port Hedland.

The GP Housing Project has been proudly delivered in partnership with BHP Billiton



Iron Ore (\$2.25 million) and the WA State Government's Royalties for Regions Pilbara Cities Programs, facilitated by the Pilbara Development Commission (\$1.5 million).

The project aims to attract and retain essential health services, and will see an increase in the specialist skills available to residents, meaning less travel to other major city centres for treatment.
