If I need help, I can find a worker with this Town uniform.


They are very friendly and will do their best to assist me.

They can do cool designs, and it might be fun to check out.


If I don't want my face touched, they can paint my arm or hand instead.

I may not want to get too close as I could get sprayed.


It might be fun to watch.

They will be all different types of food.


I will need to bring money to pay for my food.

I may have to wait in a line for my turn.


I will try to wait patiently.
