Maintenance of existing assets, reliable services, and value for ratepayers should come before projects that look impressive but lack practicality. Every major project should clearly explain the problem it is addressing, the outcomes it is expected to deliver, and how council will measure success.

Strong outcomes depend on stability, teamwork, and follow through. As Mayor, I will lead a collaborative council by drawing on the strengths, skills, and passions of all councillors, encouraging contribution where it adds the most value. Inclusive leadership and open participation are essential to sound decision making, particularly on strategic matters affecting the Town and its community.

Having served on council through a challenging period, I understand the pressures of the role and the importance of supporting new and returning councillors. I will use my experience to help guide and steady the council so it can function effectively and respectfully.

I will remain part of this community long after decisions are made, live with their outcomes, and take responsibility for ensuring they deliver long term benefit for Hedland and its residents. Leadership does not end when a vote is taken; it continues through delivery and ownership.
