



Hamilton Road Duplication

Hamilton Road is changing - from this Wednesday, works will start on the duplication of Hamilton Road which includes the dual laning of the road (where it is currently single lanes) and the construction of a new entry/exit road for Wanangkura Stadium.

Contractors will be mobilising on site from Wednesday 16 July, and works are expected to commence on Saturday 19 July.

Hamilton Road will remain open throughout the construction period and the speed limit will remain at 60km/h. We urge residents to drive with extra care and to follow any instructions provided by traffic management.

There are a great number of food and general stalls so get in early so you can browse what's on offer.

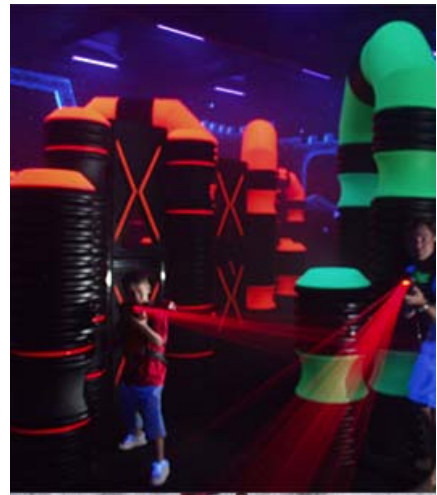
The fireworks display will take place on Saturday
