Election Packages will be sent to all electors on the local government electoral roll where there is an election in their electorate.

You may hand deliver your postal voting papers, or **obtain a replacement package** (if the package is not received, or should any papers be missing), **during business hours before election day** from the following locations:

South Hedland Public Library, 1 Leake Street, SOUTH HEDLAND Mon-Wed 10am-5pm, Thur 10am-6pm, Fri 9am-5pm, Sat 10am-1pm

Town of Port Hedland Civic Centre, 13 McGregor Street, PORT HEDLAND Mon-Fri 8am-4pm

Post your vote early. Completed postal voting packages must reach the Returning Officer by 6pm on election day, Saturday, 28 March 2026.

You may hand deliver your postal voting papers to an electoral officer, or **obtain a replacement package** (if the package is not received, or should any papers be missing), between 8am and 6pm **on election day** at the following locations:

Chief Polling Place:

Town of Port Hedland Civic Centre, 13 McGregor Street, PORT HEDLAND 8am to 6pm

Other Polling Place:

South Hedland Public Library, 1 Leake Street, SOUTH HEDLAND 8am - 6pm

The count of votes will commence after 6pm at the Gratwick Hall, 13 McGregor Street, PORT HEDLAND.
